Application for OCSEA Retiree Membership

Article II, Section 3 - OCSEA State Constitution

Membership is open to any retired employee who was an active OCSEA member at the time of retirement. Retired members shall have all rights and privileges of an active member, except the right to seek office as a president or vice president and to vote on ratification of a collective bargaining agreement. Retiree memberships shall not be available to those persons affiliated with a competing labor organization. A retired member is responsible for payment of his/her own dues on an annual basis.

Article I, Section 1(C) – OCSEA State By-Laws

Retiree Members: Effective date of membership is the date dues are received in the OCSEA central office. Dues must be submitted annually, by December 31st, to the Comptroller's Office for the following year. Dues are **\$6.00 per year.**
